

Blue Whistling-thrush

Scientific name: *Myophonus caeruleus*

Family: Muscicapidae

IUCN Red List status: LC

Trade evidence: yes

Proportion wild-caught: majority

Conservation concern due to domestic trade: moderate

Conservation concern due to international trade: low

Population declines due to trade: no, but plausible

Level of difficulty of captive breeding: hard

Captive breeding effort: rare

Selective breeding for altered phenotypes: no

Known affected subspecies: caeruleus, flavirostris, dichrohynchus
