Scientific name: *Crithagra mozambica*

Family: Fringillidae

IUCN Red List status: LC

Trade evidence: yes

Proportion wild-caught: majority

Conservation concern due to domestic trade: high

Population declines due to trade: no, but plausible

Level of difficulty of captive breeding: normal

Captive breeding effort: irregular
