

Saffron Finch

Scientific name: *Sicalis flaveola*

Family: Thraupidae

IUCN Red List status: LC

Trade evidence: yes

Proportion wild-caught: minority

Conservation concern due to domestic trade: high

Conservation concern due to international trade: moderate

Population declines due to trade: no, but plausible

Level of difficulty of captive breeding: normal

Captive breeding effort: frequent

Selective breeding for altered phenotypes: yes

Known affected subspecies: flaveola, valida, brasiliensis, pelzelni
